Supply List - (Oil Paint)

Artist grade paints, such as Winton, do not work well. Buy Utrecht or, better yet, Gamblin. They are easier to mix since they have more pigment.

Colors:

Titanium White or Mixed White, (It has a mix of zinc and titanium)

Cadmium Yellow Lemon or Cadmium Light – cool yellow

Cadmium Yellow Medium or Yellow Ochre – warm yellow

Cadmium Orange (Optional)

Cadmium Red Light – warm red

Alizarin Crimson Permanent – cool red

Ultramarine Blue – warm blue

Cobalt Blue – cool blue (Optional)

Phthalo Green (when mixed with Alizarin Crimson Permanent to create black)

Other optional colors:

Gray, either medium or dark

An earthtone such as raw umber or Gamblin Asphaltum

Brushes: hog bristle filbert or flat:

#2, 4, 6, and 10 is optional

Painting Knife:

Gamsol Paint Thinner, low odor mineral spirits is best and a small recloseable container for it

Palette for mixing paint

Viva paper towels, white

2 canvas panels 8 x 10 or 9 x 12

Optional but very useful . . . a small sketch book and wide sharpie black marker

This is good for notes and sketches
